1st day , 29 April 2010

- 08.00 departure by bus from Szeged to Belgrade
- 14.00 arrive at Belgrade railway station
- Join the ex-Presidential Blue train for trip to Branesko Polje or Romantika with an electric loco
- visit the narrow gauge museum in Pozega (see JZ 760mm gauge Mallet and 600mm Pechot -Bourdon.)
- lunch in the train
- transfer to the hotel at Mokra Gora
- dinner at Mokra Gora
- overnight

2nd day , 30 April 2010

- breakfast
- special train from Mokra Gora to Sargan Vitasi and return with steam locomotive 83-173
- lunch at Jatara station
- continue of the program with 83-173
- dinner at Mokra Gora
- overnight at Mokra Gora

3rd day , 01 May 2010

- breakfast
- special train from Mokra Gora to Dobrun, Bosnia with 0-8-2 steam locomotive 83-173
- transfer from Dobrun to Visegrad by bus

- special train Dobrun – Mokra Gora border crossing , police and customs control in the train

- Transfer by bus to Tuzla
- Dinner at Hotel Tuzla
- Overnight at Hotel Tuzla

5th day , 03 May 2010

- transfer by bus to Bukunje depot the last standard gauge steam depot in regular use
- transfer by bus to Banovici
- special train on narrow gauge line Banovici – Grivice – Turia and back with steam loco 83-158 (Austro-Hungarian 760mm gauge 0-8-2) lunch at Banovici
- visiting narrow gauge depot at Banovici , taking pictures of working standard gauge shunters class 62 (Ex USA TC) or Skoda 19-12 .
- transfer to Sarajevo
- dinner at hotel
- overnight in Holiday Inn in Sarajevo

6th day , 04 May 2010

- breakfast
- visit to Sarajevo Tramway depot
- departure by bus to Belgrade
- lunch at Mokra Gora
- arrival and check-in, Hotel Moskva, Belgrade

7th day , 05 May 2010

- breakfast
- end of tour
- go to airport for flight by own arrangements*

Something about what you'll see

Serbia is not a known railfan destination, yet there's lots to see. The highlights are: Mokra Gora, the famous 760mm gauge spirals up to Sargan; crossing the frontier into Bosnia by narrow gauge train; the remarkable narrow gauge railway museum at Pozega, with its Mallet and Pechot-Bourdon, French double-Fairlie; the Yugoslav, ex-Presidential Blue Train, on which we shall travel, and the large numbers of working steam locomotives on standard gauge that we shall see - the last steam depot in Europe with 4 working Kriegsloks, 4, 0-6-0T USTC locos, with real steam shunting at Banovici and KREKA colliery. This is a trip that really packs fascinating and rare items in to it - and of course some of those steam locomotives exist on a wing and a prayer. So if you want to see this stuff - now's your chance!
